




New Report: Bicycling and Walking Up by 25 Percent! – We're working to make the Near Southside one of the region's most pedestrian-friendly and bike-friendly destinations, and it looks like we're part of a popular trend according to a new Federal Highway Administration study. The report shows increased interest in safe alternatives to driving, with bicycling and walking trips up 25 percent nationwide since 2001. Some of FWSI's most significant efforts are aligned with these trends: the creation of complete streets that safely accommodate all users, expanded rail transit options that improve mobility and promote economic development, and more. It's great news for the Near Southside that people are looking for places where it's easy to get around on foot or bike.

Special Events Ordinance – An advisory committee has worked over the last year to draft new permitting requirements for large outdoor events. Two public hearings last month resulted in numerous revisions to the ordinance in response to concerns from neighborhoods and community organizations, including FWSI. The revised ordinance now includes a Near Southside Special Events District that would provide a simplified annual permitting process for our First Friday on the Green series. Permitting fees have not yet been finalized. The City Council will receive a briefing on the proposal on July 13th and vote on August 3rd. The ordinance is posted [on the City's website](#) for those wishing to review and comment.
